### Big Idea:

Jesus says "Go!" Next week we'll talk about how Jesus says "Tell!"

### Key Scriptures:

John 20:19-23

John 16:31-32

John 17:15-18

Colossians 1:9b-12a

Mark 1:15

1. In the message, we said "The gospel doesn't pull us inward -- it pushes us outward." Did you find this challenging at all? Encouraging? Why do we tend to have an inward pull rather than an outward orientation when it comes to our understanding and application of the gospel?

2. We have an option with our Go Factor, seeing it as either a "centripetal mission" (lazy river) or "centrifugal mission" (water slide). Which of these metaphors best describes your personal experience? What are the benefits and drawbacks of each approach?

3. The disciples experienced a shift... from fear to peace, observation to commission, empty to empowered, and silence to witness. Which of these shifts resonates most with you personally right now, and what steps might God be calling you toward to grow in these areas?

4. Does Jesus matter enough to turn your life outward? How does this question challenge your current priorities, use of time, and relationships? What is one small, practical step you could take this week to be more "outward-facing" in your life?

5. Near the end of the message, we talked about what we might think, feel, and do. For review:

**THINK** - If Jesus really rose from the dead, then my life doesn't belong to me anymore.

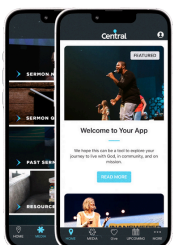
**FEEL** - I can't be content playing it safe anymore.

**DO** - I'm stepping toward someone this week, not away.

Based on the above, what are some potential next steps? In light of these, what is Jesus calling you to?

6. Who in your circle needs to see a faithful follower of Jesus and — tough question — do they see that in you?

7. As you pray for each other, ask the Lord to bring someone to mind that you might invite to sit with you next Sunday at Central.
