

A Confident Faith That Flourishes

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BIG IDEA

A genuine, confident faith flourishes when we trust God's truth, live from our identity in Him, and use our words and lives to influence others.

KEY SCRIPTURES

2 Timothy 1:5-7, Proverbs 31:25-26, Hebrews 10:35-36, Psalms 139:13-17, Proverbs 3:26, Philippians 1:6, John 1:1,14

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1. Paul described Timothy's faith as genuine and shaped by the influence of others. Who has had the biggest impact on your faith journey?
 2. What fear, insecurity, or lie most often tries to steal your confidence or keep you from fully trusting God?
 3. 2 Timothy 1:7 says God has not given us a spirit of fear. What would it look like to live with more confidence, love, and peace in this season?
 4. How have someone's words – either positive or negative – shaped the way you see yourself?
 5. Proverbs 31 says wisdom and kindness should be on our tongues. Who in your life today needs encouragement, truth, or kindness from you?
 6. The message highlighted the importance of genuine faith. What helps your relationship with God stay real and personal instead of just routine or outward?
 7. How does knowing you were intentionally created and deeply loved by God change the way you view your story, gifts, or struggles?
 8. God works in difficult situations and painful seasons. Where do you need renewed hope or confidence in God today?
 9. God used people like Lois, Eunice, Paul, and others to influence the next generation. How can you intentionally invest in or encourage someone else's faith?
 10. Philippians 1:6 reminds us that God will complete the good work He started in us. What is one area of your life where you need to trust that God is still working?
