BIG IDEA:


In this new chapter, the goal isn't comfort—it's Christ, front and center.

8. What resistance—internal or external—are you facing as you consider stepping deeper into discipleship and the mission of Christ?
9. What personal “edge” or advantage do you rely on to get ahead—and how might God be inviting you to lay it down this year?
